6 Day Morocco Tour - Full Itinerary - Marrakech start

Welcome to our Morocco Adventure Tour. We have a fabulous schedule which we are confident will be one of the most memorable experiences of your life.

Highlights – Ouarzazate – Tizi n Tichka Pass – Draa Valley- M'Hamid



Day 1. Arrival day Marrakech

Al-Andalus (Marrakech) - Group dinner at hotel

Day 2. Marrakech-Ouarzazate

Today we head towards the mighty and spectacular Tizi-n-Tichka Pass, the road which connects Marrakech with the pre-Sahara oasis. We will visit Ait-Benhaddou, one of the best preserved casbahs in the whole Atlas region and then we arrive at Ouarzazate and share a cold beer at the hotel New Belere's swimming pool terrace. On our ride through the Tizi-n-Tichka section, we will see many people offering coloured rocks and fossils as this region is famous for its minerals and rocks formations.



Day 3. Ouarzazate - M'Hamid

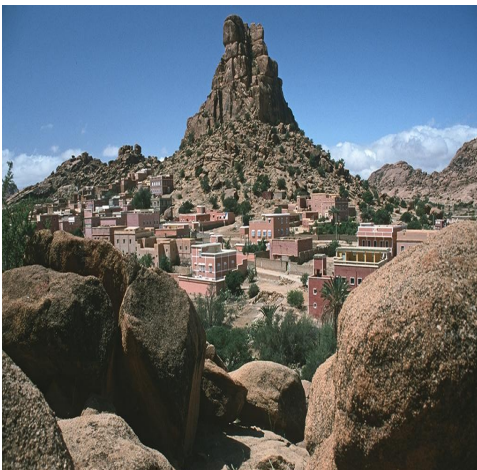
Today we ride south through the magical Dráa Valley Oasis, up to Zagora, where the open plains start and will surround us all the way down to M'Hamid. The Dráa valley gives its name to the river, one of the longest in Morocco. It originates in the High Atlas and reaches the Atlantic at Cap Dráa, just north of Tan Tan where the waters generally seep away into the desert. The richest section of the valley lies between Agdz and Zagora, a stretch of about 95 km of technicoloured palmeries, orchards, casbahs and stunning Berber villages where local children try to sell boxes of dates, some of the sweetest of the region. The oasis of M'Hamid is the goal of the long trip south. It used to be an important marketplace for the trans-saharan trade and the town has many different ethnic groups including Harratine, Berber, Chorfa and Beni M'hamed. We'll see a spectacular 40km stretch of 300m Saharan dunes and here we will spend an authentic night under the stars at the Erg Chigaga dunes in a typical haima – an unforgettable experience.



Day 4. M'Hamid - Tazenakht

Today we have the opportunity to ride on some non-tarmac surfaces on our way north to the Anti Atlas, the last mountain range before the Sahara. The pink and ochre coloured chain of the Anti Atlas and the open plateau will transport us to a totally different type of scenery, very typical desert landscape and absolutely stunning.

Exploring the lunar landscape of the Anti Atlas is one of the most unforgettable excursions in Morocco, the main colours of the granite boulders and red lava flows are soft pinks and mauves through to golden browns.



Day 5. Tazenakht - Marrakech

Today we will cross the Tizi-n-Test Pass, one of the most spectacular and perilous passes in the country where the views are often breathtaking. We will be riding around the Toubkal Mountain from south to north, this mountain is 4.167 m high, the panoramas are stunning on this route, so make sure you have your camera ready to use.

Taliouine is dominated by the impressive Glaoui Casbah and is famous for saffron - it takes about 140 to 230 flowers to produce one gram of the most expensive spice in the world - really incredible. We will finish the tour with an evening feast at the Comptoir Darma restaurant



Day 6. Departure day
